AKC ALL BREED FAST CAT

Open to all AKC Registered and Mixed Breeds (via AKC Canine Partners).

Each dog must be individually registered with the AKC. This includes all AKC registered purebreds, Foundation Stock Service (FSS), Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL), and AKC Canine Partners Spayed or Neutered dogs, or dogs with breed disqualifications may be entered. If **not AKC registered**, you can register your Canine Partner with AKC at the event, and your dog can participate in the tests that very same day.

WE DO NOT DO BLOCK SCHEDULES FOR RUN TIMES. THIS IS FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE. THIS IS A ROLLING ROLL CALL.

PRIORITY RUNS WILL BE FOR EARLY ENTRIES. SAME DAY ENTRIES AND FUN RUNS WORKED IN BEGINNING AFTER 10:00 EACH DAY (earlier if there is little wait).

Due to the compressed/short schedule on SUNDAY, there will be NO Fun Runs unless otherwise posted in BKC Facebook group.

Please note we may have to limit or eliminate Gate Entries and Fun Runs each day depending on weather, temperature, and staff/volunteer availability.

Although we endeavor to have enough rosettes on hand, that is not always the case. If we run out of rosettes, we will reorder and send to you.

EVENT DAY PROCEDURES

Each dog will be inspected by the Inspection Committee for lameness, fitness to compete, and females in season. All dogs to be inspected must be presented without tape, bandages, or wrapping/coverings of any kind (coats, blankets, etc.). If, in the opinion of the inspection committee, a dog is found to be lame, unfit to compete, or in season, the dog will not be allowed to test, and the applicable entry fees will be refunded.

All entrants will assemble in a designated location. At this time, test procedures will be explained, and any questions answered.

Dogs will be brought to the start line on leash and released only upon a verbal signal ("Tally-Ho!") from the Huntmaster. Dogs may be released by hand, folded leash, or using a traditional lure coursing slip lead.

Dogs may run with or without a collar for safety reasons. Unacceptable collars are choker collar, prong collar, Martingale collar, or electronic collar. Tags, bandanas, or other similar items are not allowed for safety reasons. Owners may use clips or rubber bands to hold the dog's hair. The owner assumes responsibility for the safety of the dog regarding the dog's collar and paraphernalia on the dog. Electronic training collars or pinch/prong collars are NOT allowed on AKC test grounds.

FAST CAT

The Fast CAT is a timed straight race of 100 yards where a dog chases a lure. Dogs run singularly and earn points based on their handicapped speed. There are no placements. Titles are issued at designated benchmarks. The dog's time to complete the 100-yard dash is converted into MPH. Dogs earn points based on their handicapped speed.

A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5
- Below 12" = handicap is 2.0

Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap

Fast CAT titles suffix titles are earned at designated milestones:

- BCAT = 150 points
- DCAT = 500 points
- FCAT = 1,000 points
- FCAT# = every additional 500 points

The AKC Fast CAT website will feature the Top 20 Fastest Dogs by Breed by Year national standings. The standings will be updated as event results are processed.



PHOTOGRAPHY

Brian Batista of Brian Batista Photography is the official photographer for these events. No other photographer will be allowed to photograph dogs/people without the express consent of Brian Batista Photography and the Field Trial Chairman.

(Only exception is persons with cell phones and their own dogs).

Anyone caught photographing these events, or any portion thereof, without permission will be asked to leave the field. An AKC Event Committee hearing may also be called if unsportsmanlike behavior is

MISCELLANEOUS

- Open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered/listed with the AKC. This includes dogs recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. (An event number defines an event.)
- **Safety:** Safety is of utmost importance. It is the responsibility of the event committee to ensure the safety of the course, the equipment, and the conduct of those involved with the event.
- **The Start:** Dogs may start up to 10 feet behind the starting line.
- **The Finish:** The club must provide enough room for a safe run-out area. It is recommended that an owner or someone familiar with the dog stand at the finish to catch the dog once the course has been completed. BKC provides a minimum of 50 yard run off but if Greyhounds or Borzois are pre-registered, then we do a 75-yard run off to allow these breeds time to slow and come to a stop.
- **Lure Equipment:** Battery-powered, continuous loop equipment will be used. Lures consist of white plastic bags. Electronic break-the-beam timing system will be used with manual timing as a backup for equipment failure and rainy weather.
- For the safety of the dog and as a courtesy to other entrants, a testing dog should have a reliable recall. A penalty of **\$20.00** may be assessed for any dog causing an excessive delay of the event because it cannot be recalled or retrieved from the field. Dogs that delay the event because their owners cannot recall them may be refused entry at future events.
- You will be charged \$5.00 if you do not pick up after your dog.
- These events will be run concurrently. Dogs that have not yet run will have priority over dogs that will be running for the second test.
- BKC will break periodically to accommodate workers and allow for lunch.
- Event is held in rain-or-shine - outdoor event. Please plan accordingly.
- Dogs should be walked prior to running to warm them up and again after their run to cool them down.
- The handler may NOT run down the course to entice the dog to run or use toys/treats to get the dog to run. They CAN call their dog from the catch area. Handlers may carry toys or treats on their persons to assist with retrieving their dogs at the completion of their run. Please review the published AKC rules pertaining to Fast CAT.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- Handlers should wear comfortable shoes and be physically able to hold and release their dogs, as well as catch them.
- Lure coursing is a physically demanding sport so please make sure your dog is in good shape. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.
- Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the test by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Children must always be under control of their parents or guardian(s).
- Each dog/per event requires an entry form.
- Late, incomplete, unsigned, unpaid, or conditional entries, or entries not containing the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form will not be accepted.
- Mixed breeds must be spayed or neutered to be eligible to run. AKC registered dogs with breed disqualifications may be entered.
- Run area is fully fenced.
- **No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.**

- **No refunds for pre-entry fees unless the entered dog upon inspection is lame, unfit to compete, or in season.**
- A return check fee of **\$40.00** will be assessed for any check(s) returned for insufficient funds.




EMERGENCY CARE PLAN: DOGS

The show veterinarian is on call all weekend & can be reached during all hours by telephone. If a dog needs to be transported to the veterinary clinic, the owner will be assisted (if requested) by a member of the board or club to ensure that the dog gets to the veterinary clinic as fast as possible. If the dog can be treated at the show site by the show veterinarian on call or by a licensed veterinarian in attendance, a designated area will be determined by the show chairman.

Dogs being left by agents or owners in grooming building overnight are requested to identify the dog's crate with an emergency phone number or information in case of an emergency.

FIT DOG

AWARDS: Fit Dog Rosette per walk completed
Limited to 30 dogs per walk (if a lot of interest, we will add a second walk on Saturday evening)

DAYS: Friday & Saturday

TIME: 4:00 PM Line up

ROUTE: See photo 1.03 miles (see photo). 2 Laps around the Expo Center

Sign up all day. Line up will be at 4:00 PM. Walk will begin at 4:10. Walk and final paperwork should take about 45 minutes.

Bitches in season As a courtesy, bitches in season should not be taken to group activities such as fitness classes or activities where other dogs are present. Examples include community runs and hikes. If it is possible, bitches in season may run or walk after the group.

Age of dogs Dogs must be at least 6 months old to earn the Bronze AKC FIT DOG title. Dogs must be registered or enrolled with AKC and have an AKC, PAL, or AKC Canine Partners number when the Title Application is submitted.

All dogs must be leashed ~ At AKC FIT DOG activities, dogs may wear slip collars, buckle collars, Martingales, and body harnesses. They may not wear prong collars or e-collars. Muzzles may be worn only in events that permit muzzles. Head collars may be worn unless they are prohibited by a specific activity for safety reasons (e.g., when a dog is running the agility course, the only collars allowed are flat buckle or rolled leather collars). Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric or leather.

Paperwork – How to Submit Your Titles Owner: Once the dog has earned the required number of points to earn a title, the dog owner should send to AKC 1) a copy of the AKC FIT DOG Title Application with the fee for the title, 2) the checklist for each of the 6 categories showing the points earned and 3) all of the necessary documentation described in Part II. The paperwork may be mailed to the address or email address at the top of the title application, or preferably, it may be submitted online to the Title Application Portal (TAP). TAP allows you to submit the paperwork and fee as well as track the progress of the title. <https://www.apps.akc.org/title-application-portal/>
